Applications should be submitted by the internship candidate by **5 pm on April 20th**. Internships are available to undergraduate students of any nationality. Interns must not have completed their final examinations. It is expected that the most competitive students will be those entering their final year. Eligible supervisors are those who may supervise M.Sc./Ph.D. students. Candidates should make contact directly with prospective supervisors to discuss projects and to arrange for the submission of the required recommendation.
