THINGS TO CONSIDER IN YOUR PYTHON CODE

These items are not necessarily in "order of importance". Some ideas apply to ALL programs, and some ideas only apply to some programs.

- 1. The program does not crash
- 2. The program gets the right answer!
- 3. The code is tested on a number of different inputs
- 4. There are many comments in the code (written in clear english). Aim to have nearly as many lines of comments as lines of code.
- 5. Function and variable names are chosen in a meaningful way use short words if possible
- 6. There is no redundant code (code that does not do anything). Remove redundant code before sending in your program
- 7. Program is as short as possible
- 8. Program is as efficient as possible
